

Flipped Classroom Open House

On Tuesday, March 10, 2015, International Business will host an open house with hosts Luisa Arrivillaga and Alexandra Montague, Spanish Teachers.

Flipped Classroom Open Houses are intended to shed light on the flipped learning approach and encourage other teachers and administrators to give flipped learning a try in their own schools/universities. They help to share the experiences of flipped educators with others.



The classroom session will cover Spanish, A1-A2 level:

- 8:45-10:15 classroom visits
- 10:15-11:15 presentation and Q&A round
- 11:15-13:00 classroom visits

Mrs. Arrivillaga and Mrs. Montague have been flipping their Spanish class since September 2014. The results until now are very positive; students are more responsible for their own learning process, they are more aware of their own capacities, show more interest in the course, are more motivated and have better grades.

Flipped learning happens when the teacher's lecture is delivered outside of the traditional class time, via a video students view on their own, either in the classroom or outside the classroom. Class time is used for active problem solving by students and one-to-one or small group tutoring with the teacher. Students can watch the short lectures as many times as they wish to grasp the content and then come to class ready to jump into the lesson, answer questions, work on collaborative projects, and explore the content further. Teachers are embracing Flipped Learning in elementary, secondary schools, and higher education for all disciplines.
